16 February

17 February

18 February

19 February

22 February

24 February

25 February

28 February

Pray for outreach events going on as believers look to leverage the holidays to share with non-believers in their sphere of influence. Pray the Gospel would be shared boldly and many would turn to Christ for salvation.



1 March

Believers will gather today to worship God in spirit and in truth. Pray this Scripture to be experienced today.

2 March
